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## Warwick Hospital.

Ward Remodelling Works

### New Kitchenette/Admin Offices and meeting rooms.

DHA were appointed to help redesign existing areas of the Hospital Wards to create new kitchenette, admin rooms and meeting rooms in the Charelcote Suite Squire Ward, Dugdale Suite and Avon Suite.

The works were phased to minimize the disruption to the live ward. In conjunction with this the design works took into account the efficiency of work being carried out simultaneously to help keep costs low.

### Refurbishment

DHA have been involved in the long term refurbishment of this existing care home to improve the provision in line with CQC requirements.

Works have comprised the complete refurbishment of the building with a further phase of demolition and re-building of one of the nursing wings as a separate project.

The scheme has included the provision of new mechanical and electrical services alongside the enlarging of bedroom and en-suite accommodation with the provision of further communal spaces to foster resident inclusivity.

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## St Joseph's New Wing, Manchester

RIBA stage 0-7

### New Build Wing

DHA Architects have delivered a new 3 storey extension to provide 18 new nursing care bedrooms, ancillary spaces along with new independent living apartments.

In line with the Sister's ethos, the new nursing rooms are equipped with en-suite's built-in wardrobes and a small kitchenette facility to create a homely environment, allowing family members to congregate in the resident's room, extending privacy and visiting time.

Provision of assisted living apartments on site further extends the sister's ability to offer extra care to residents whilst fostering their continuing independence for as long as possible



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## Mary Seacole / Meadowcroft PICU

RIBA Stages A-L

### New Build Extension.

Meadowcroft is a medium secure unit located in Birmingham. The existing building is not a purpose PICU and the building has been extended/modified over the years.

Our clients brief was to provide a new seclusion room including a number of improvements to the existing accommodation following a recent CQC inspection. The addition of the new room required a number of changes to the existing layout to ensure the room was integrated.

DHA started with an initial feasibility report outlining the design intent, outline specification, costs and construction programme. This was helpful to co-ordinate the project from the outset as well as allowing the trust to consult with ward staff, clinicians and users.



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## Warwick Hospital.

RIBA stage 0-7

### Kitchen Improvement Works

South Warwickshire NHS Foundation Trust required changes to the existing food service arrangements. The existing kitchen provision and cold storage facilities needed upgrading and remodeling to ensure services could be delivered effectively and safely through out the day.

The works were designed closely with the professional catering team to ensure systems could be phased without too much disruption to the food service.

The existing M/E services need to be renewed and included new power supplies to the hot trolleys, freezer and fridge units. The kitchen area was further divided to create separate areas wash facilities.



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## Ashcroft PICU

RIBA Stages 0-7

### Design of New Anti-climb Roof and Fencing.

The work comprised the replacement of the perimeter fencing with new 3.2/5.2m high anti-climb secure privacy fencing.

The existing single storey roofs were modified to include a new anti-climb barrier (shown below). The barrel design was created closely with the BSMHT and FM Management Team to ensure the existing maintenance and safety of the site was not compromised.

An additional privacy mesh was added internally to reduce the harsh impact of the fence which also helped overcome planning issues relating to the close proximity of the fence to residential properties.

## St Peter's Care Home London

RIBA Stages 0-7

### Refurbishment/ Extension

DHA Architects have been commissioned to prepare the designs for the refurbishment of the Care Bed-room accommodation so as to introduce new en-suite shower rooms and generally improve accessibility for staff using mobile hoists.

As part of the design the formation of an additional element of 3rd care accommodation will be added to maintain the overall care bed-room numbers (i.e. compensating for those that would be lost within the various care units from the introduction of new en-suite shower rooms) and in order to enable the phasing of the works, which would require unit care bedrooms to be vacated whilst the phased refurbishment works were undertaken.

The project is currently in its planning stages.

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## Lordswood Medical Practice

### Conversion

DHA were appointed to convert the existing smaller offices into a large single open plan area. The conversion included the relocation of existing prescription booth, Staff kitchenette and toilet facilities.

DHA prepared a number of early stage CAD models to help the practice understand the full implications of the works and its impact on the existing spaces.

The contract works were undertaken during a difficult period of Covid-19 and intense working conditions. DHA developed the design and contract stages to help priorities the Health & Safety matters without compromising on quality.



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## Father Hudsons Care, Coleshill

RIBA Stages 0-7

### Refurbishment

DHA Architects have transformed an existing 1930's detached house to create 3 separate assisted living apartments and on-site care staff facilities.

The practice worked closely with Father Hudson's Care to establish end user requirements in order to tailor the spaces which would be created within the scheme.

Each flat was given its own en-suite accommodation and new open-plan kitchen / living rooms. The internal layout and finishes were carefully considered to create homely environments for users with a variety of disabilities.
